**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Increases amount of damages recoverable from person unlawfully acting as a farm labor contractor from \$500 to \$2000.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:** Provisions of the measure.

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Any person who supplies farm or forest laborers for farming or reforestation is required to have a Farm and Forest Labor Contractor license from the Bureau of Labor and Industries. Currently, the penalty for failing to have a valid license is \$500 or actual damages. SB 203 increases the penalty to \$2000.
