WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows the State Accident Insurance Fund (SAIF) to contract with the Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to provide claim management services for claims filed by prisoners for injuries suffered during authorized work or occupational training.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- SAIF's history of administering claims by prisoners under ORS 656.752
- Need for clarification of SAIF's authority to contract with DAS to provide claims administration services in these circumstances
- Similarities between prisoner's claims and workers' compensation claims

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: ORS 655.505 to 655.555 provides that, if certain statutory requirements are met, inmates may receive benefits for injuries suffered during an authorized work or occupational training assignment. Claims for injuries to inmates are handled by the Risk Management Division of DAS. Since 1991, DAS has contracted with SAIF to manage these claims because they are similar to workers' compensation claims. SB 233 clarifies that SAIF has the authority to contract with DAS to provide this service.
