**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires the Department of Education to collect data on amount of physical education provided to kindergarten through grade 8 students. Requires department to report to legislature on data collected every other year. Declares an emergency; effective July 1, 2007.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Need for legislation to authorize data collection
- Additional cost for data collection

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Requires Department of Education to report to legislature on data collected every other year.

**BACKGROUND:** Currently, there are standards for physical education, however there are no regular assessments or surveys to ensure that schools implement and follow those standards. This bill would require the Department of Education to collect data on the amount of physical education provided and report to the legislature on their findings.
