EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Mt. Hood Community College Child Development Center opened in 1970 as a laboratory school and child care center. Today, the center enrolls about 90 children, aged 12 months to five years old, of students, staff, faculty, and the general community. In addition to providing child care, it serves as a classroom for college students in the early childhood education program. The center is housed in modular classrooms that have dry rot, an older electrical system, and leaking roofs. A new child care facility was included in a \$58.8 million bond measure that failed to garner voter approval in November 2006.
