WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Adds police officers to the list of eligible public employees that may request the Department of Transportation substitute the officers' work addresses instead of their residential addresses in their records.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Inadvertent deletion of police officers from statute last session

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 276.021 states that police officers appointed to protect state buildings are eligible to request the work address substitution. ORS 276.023 authorizes police officers appointed to protect the State Capitol to do so as well. SB 537 would add state police, sheriffs, deputy sheriffs, and city police officers. These officers used to be included as eligible public employees, but were inadvertently deleted from statute last session.
