**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires the Director of Consumer and Business Services to approve a managed-care organizations' process for adopting treatment standards for injured workers instead of the actual treatment standards.

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Currently, the Director of Consumer and Business Services reviews and approves treatment standards as part of the certification process for managed-care organizations. SB 563 removes the requirement to review and approve individual standards but requires approval by the director for the process of adopting treatment standards.
