WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Urges Congress to pass legislation and to approve funds for assisting National Guard and Reservists transitioning to civilian life following active service. Urges Congress to pass legislation requiring the Secretary of Defense to develop a coordinated transition program for the National Guard and to use specific funds for the program.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Current reintegration programs
- Issues facing returning combat veterans
- Other provisions of the measure

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Oregon National Guard is among the nation's leaders in actively assisting demobilized members to transition back to their families, jobs, schools, and communities. The Reintegration Team provides post-mobilization support to soldiers by establishing a central contact point for the agencies that provide support and benefits to soldiers and their dependents.
