SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Specifies minimum number of instructional days school district must provide each school year.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to school year.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Each school district shall provide no fewer than 180 instructional days**
5 **each school year to students who attend the schools of the district.**

6 **(2) The State Board of Education shall adopt by rule requirements for what constitutes**
7 **an instructional day for purposes of subsection (1) of this section. The board may require**
8 **different minimum and maximum numbers of hours in an instructional day according to the**
9 **grade level of the student.**

10 **(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, if a school district has a four-day**
11 **school week, the board may require a number of instructional days each school year that is**
12 **less than the number required by subsection (1) of this section and increase the number of**
13 **instructional hours required each day.**

14 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2007 Act first applies to the 2008-2009 school year.**
