## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Specifies minimum number of instructional days school district must provide each school year.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to school year.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) Each school district shall provide no fewer than 180 instructional days
5	each school year to students who attend the schools of the district.
6	(2) The State Board of Education shall adopt by rule requirements for what constitutes
7	an instructional day for purposes of subsection (1) of this section. The board may require
8	different minimum and maximum numbers of hours in an instructional day according to the
9	grade level of the student.
10	(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, if a school district has a four-day
11	school week, the board may require a number of instructional days each school year that is
12	less than the number required by subsection (1) of this section and increase the number of
13	instructional hours required each day.
14	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2007 Act first applies to the 2008-2009 school year.
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
