

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2121

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 29 through 33.

2 On page 4, delete lines 15 through 21 and insert:

3 “(8)(a) Any person may request in writing that an agency send to the person copies of the  
4 agency’s notices of intended action issued under subsection (1) of this section. The person must  
5 provide an address where the person elects to receive notices. The address provided may be a postal  
6 mailing address or, if the agency provides notice by electronic mail, may be an electronic mailing  
7 address.

8 “(b) A request under this subsection must indicate that the person requests one of the following:

9 “(A) The person may request that the agency mail paper copies of the proposed rule and other  
10 information required by subsection (2) of this section to the postal mailing address.

11 “(B) If the agency posts notices of intended action on a website, the person may request that  
12 the agency mail the information required by subsection (2)(a) of this section to the postal mailing  
13 address with a reference to the website where electronic copies of the proposed rule and other in-  
14 formation required by subsection (2) of this section are posted.

15 “(C) If the agency provides notice by electronic mail, the person may request that the agency  
16 electronically mail the information required by subsection (2)(a) of this section to the electronic  
17 mailing address, and either provide electronic copies of the proposed rule and other information  
18 required by subsection (2) of this section or provide a reference to a website where electronic copies  
19 of the proposed rule and other information required by subsection (2) of this section are posted.

20 “(c) Upon receipt of any request under this subsection, the agency shall acknowledge the re-  
21 quest, establish a mailing list and maintain a record of all mailings made pursuant to the request.  
22 Agencies may establish procedures for establishing the mailing lists and keeping the mailing lists  
23 current. Agencies by rule may establish fees necessary to defray the costs of mailings and mainte-  
24 nance of the lists.”.
