SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes agency to delegate authority to enter final order in proceeding or class of proceedings to officer or employee of agency.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to delegation of agency authority to issue orders.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 183.**

5 **SECTION 2. Unless otherwise provided by law, an agency may delegate authority to enter**
6 **a final order in a proceeding or class of proceedings to an officer or employee of the agency.**
7 **A delegation of authority under this section must be made in writing before the entry of any**
8 **order pursuant to the delegation and must be retained in the agency's records. The delega-**
9 **tion form must name the authorized officers or employees, and the officers and employees**
10 **must acknowledge the delegation by signing the form.**
