

House Bill 2126

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that interest earned by Criminal Injuries Compensation Account is to be credited to account.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to interest earned by Criminal Injuries Compensation Account; amending ORS 147.225; and
3 declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 147.225 is amended to read:

6 147.225. [*There is established*] The Criminal Injuries Compensation Account **is established,**
7 **separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Criminal Injuries Com-**
8 **ensation Account shall be credited to the account.** All moneys in the account are continuously
9 appropriated [*for*] **to** and may be used by the Department of Justice for the purposes authorized in
10 ORS 135.905 and 147.005 to 147.367 and section 2, chapter 789, Oregon Laws 2003.

11 **SECTION 2.** ORS 147.225, as amended by section 6, chapter 789, Oregon Laws 2003, is amended
12 to read:

13 147.225. [*There is established*] The Criminal Injuries Compensation Account **is established,**
14 **separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Criminal Injuries Com-**
15 **ensation Account shall be credited to the account.** All moneys in the account are continuously
16 appropriated [*for*] **to** and may be used by the Department of Justice for the purposes authorized in
17 ORS 135.905 and 147.005 to 147.367.

18 **SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
19 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
20 **July 1, 2007.**
