

# House Bill 2177

Ordered printed by the Speaker pursuant to House Rule 12.00A (5). Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor Theodore R. Kulongoski for Department of Human Services)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Extends sunset of Medicaid managed care assessment.  
Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to managed care assessment; amending sections 45, 49, 50 and 51, chapter 736, Oregon  
3 Laws 2003; prescribing an effective date; and providing for revenue raising that requires ap-  
4 proval by a three-fifths majority.

5 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 45, chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003, is amended to read:

7 **Sec. 45.** Sections 37 to 44, **chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003**, [*of this 2003 Act*] apply to managed  
8 care premiums received by prepaid managed care health services organizations on or after January  
9 1, 2004, and before [*January 1, 2008*] **October 1, 2009**.

10 **SECTION 2.** Section 49, chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003, is amended to read:

11 **Sec. 49.** Sections 37 to 44, **chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003**, [*of this 2003 Act*] are repealed on  
12 January 2, [*2010*] **2012**.

13 **SECTION 3.** Section 50, chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003, is amended to read:

14 **Sec. 50.** Nothing in the repeal of sections 37 to 44, **chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003**, [*of this*  
15 *2003 Act*] by section 49, **chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003**, [*of this 2003 Act*] affects the imposition  
16 and collection of a prepaid managed care health services organization assessment under sections 37  
17 to 44, **chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003**, [*of this 2003 Act*] for a calendar quarter beginning before  
18 [*January 1, 2008*] **October 1 2009**.

19 **SECTION 4.** Section 51, chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003, is amended to read:

20 **Sec. 51.** Any moneys remaining in the Medical Care Quality Assurance Fund on December 31,  
21 [*2009*] **2011**, are transferred to the General Fund.

22 **SECTION 5.** **This 2007 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the reg-**  
23 **ular session of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
