**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

*[Grants Department of Corrections discretion in determining form of special alternative incarceration program.]* **Requires special alternative incarceration program established by Department of Corrections to reflect evidence-based practices and include component of intensive self-discipline, physical work and physical exercise. Grants department discretion regarding inclusion of drug and alcohol treatment component in special alternative incarceration program.** Extends duration of special alternative incarceration program.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to corrections; amending ORS 421.504; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 421.504 is amended to read:

5 421.504. (1) The Department of Corrections, in consultation with the Oregon Criminal Justice  
6 Commission, shall establish a special alternative incarceration program stressing a highly structured  
7 and regimented routine. The program:

8 *[(a) Shall be based on a military basic training model that includes extensive discipline, physical*  
9 *work, physical exercise and military drill;]*

10 **(a) Shall reflect evidence-based practices;**

11 **(b) Shall include a component of intensive self-discipline, physical work and physical ex-**  
12 **ercise;**

13 *[(b)]* **(c)** Shall provide for cognitive restructuring in conformance with generally accepted  
14 rehabilitative standards;

15 *[(c)]* **(d)** *[Shall]* **May** include a drug and alcohol treatment component that meets the standards  
16 promulgated by the Department of Human Services pursuant to ORS 430.357; and

17 *[(d)]* **(e)** Shall be *[no longer than]* **at least** 270 days' duration.

18 (2) The department shall provide capital improvements and capital construction necessary for  
19 the implementation of the program.

20 (3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the department may convert the special al-  
21 ternative incarceration program required by this section into an intensive alternative incarceration  
22 addiction program as described in ORS 421.506 if the department determines that the needs of  
23 offenders in the department's custody would be better served by an intensive alternative  
24 incarceration addiction program than by the special alternative incarceration program.

25 **SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
