SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to develop plan to eliminate sunset of provisions related to services provided by nurse practitioners in workers' compensation claims.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall develop a plan to**
5 **eliminate the repeal of the authority granted to nurse practitioners to provide medical ser-**
6 **vices in workers' compensation claims as required by sections 32 and 33, chapter 811, Oregon**
7 **Laws 2003.**
