

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2263

- 2 In line 5, delete “339.115.”
- 3 On page 3, lines 15 and 16, delete the boldfaced material and restore the bracketed material.
- 4 In lines 38 and 39, delete the boldfaced material and restore the bracketed material.
- 5 On page 4, lines 6 through 12, delete the boldfaced material and restore the bracketed material.
- 6 On page 6, delete lines 25 through 45.
- 7 On page 7, delete lines 1 through 40 and insert:
- 8 “**SECTION 8.** ORS 329.115 is amended to read:
- 9 “329.115. (1) Prior to September 30 of each year, the Superintendent of Public Instruction shall
- 10 issue an Oregon Report Card on the state of the public schools and progress toward achieving the
- 11 goals contained in ORS 329.025 [*and 329.035*].
- 12 “(2) The purpose of the Oregon Report Card is to monitor trends among school districts and
- 13 Oregon’s progress toward achieving the goals stated in this chapter. The report on the state of the
- 14 public schools shall be designed to:
- 15 “(a) Allow educators and local citizens to determine and share successful and unsuccessful
- 16 school programs;
- 17 “(b) Allow educators to sustain support for reforms demonstrated to be successful;
- 18 “(c) Recognize schools for their progress and achievements; and
- 19 “(d) Facilitate the use of educational resources and innovations in the most effective manner.
- 20 “(3) The report shall contain, but need not be limited to:
- 21 “(a) Demographic information on public school children in this state.
- 22 “(b) Information pertaining to student achievement, including statewide assessment data, grad-
- 23 uation rates and dropout rates, including progress toward achieving the education benchmarks es-
- 24 tablished by the Oregon Progress Board, with arrangements by minority groupings where applicable.
- 25 “(c) Information pertaining to special program offerings.
- 26 “(d) Information pertaining to the characteristics of the school and school staff, including as-
- 27 signment of teachers, experience of staff and the proportion of minorities and women represented
- 28 on the teaching and administrative staff.
- 29 “(e) Budget information, including source and disposition of school district operating funds and
- 30 salary data.
- 31 “(f) Examples of exemplary programs, proven practices, programs designed to reduce costs or
- 32 other innovations in education being developed by school districts in this state that show improved
- 33 student learning.
- 34 “(g) Such other information as the superintendent obtains under ORS 329.105.
- 35 “(4) In the second and subsequent years that the report is issued, the report shall include a

1 comparison between the current and previous data and an analysis of trends in public education.  
2 **“NOTE:** Section 9 was deleted by amendment. Subsequent sections were not renumbered.”.  
3 On page 11, line 44, restore “met or”.  
4 On page 12, line 3, delete “diploma” and insert “credential”.  
5 In line 21, delete “classroom work samples”.  
6 On page 21, delete lines 37 through 45.  
7 On page 22, delete lines 1 through 39 and insert:  
8 **“NOTE:** Section 34 was deleted by amendment. Subsequent sections were not renumbered.”.  
9 On page 27, line 30, delete “329.125,”.  
10 In line 32, delete “339.115,”.  
11 In line 33, after “2005” insert a comma.  
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
