

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2294

By COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND THE ENVIRONMENT

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “315.138,” insert “496.085.”
- 2 On page 2, line 1, after “after” delete the rest of the line and insert “January 1, 1996, unless the  
3 Fish Screening Task Force finds there is good cause to allow an exception. The department shall  
4 give preference to diversions of 30 cubic feet per second or less when making cost-sharing program  
5 funds available.”.
- 6 After line 28, insert:  
7 “(7) A person who diverts water at a rate of 30 cubic feet per second or more is responsible for  
8 all maintenance of an installed screening or by-pass device.”.
- 9 In line 29, delete “(7)” and insert “(8)”.
- 10 In line 37, delete “(8)” and insert “(9)”.
- 11 In line 41, delete “(9)(a)” and insert “(10)(a)”.
- 12 On page 3, line 7, restore the bracketed material.
- 13 In line 8, restore the bracketed material and delete “\$25” and insert “\$150” and delete the rest  
14 of the line.
- 15 In line 9, delete “cost”.
- 16 In line 15, delete “(10)” and insert “(11)”.
- 17 In line 18, delete “(11)” and insert “(12)”.
- 18 In line 22, delete “(12)” and insert “(13)”.
- 19 In line 29, delete “(13)(a)” and insert “(14)(a)”.
- 20 On page 4, line 24, delete “(14)” and insert “(15)”.
- 21 On page 6, line 25, delete “(7)” and insert “(8)”.
- 22 On page 10, line 9, before “498.316” insert “498.306.”.
- 23 On page 11, line 13, before “498.316” insert “498.306.”.
- 24 After line 38, insert:  
25 “**SECTION 5a.** ORS 496.085 is amended to read:  
26 “496.085. (1) There is established within the State Department of Fish and Wildlife the Fish  
27 Screening Task Force consisting of seven members appointed by the State Fish and Wildlife Com-  
28 mission.  
29 “(2) Three members shall be appointed to represent agricultural interests, three shall be ap-  
30 pointed to represent fishing or fish conservation interests and one member shall be appointed to  
31 represent the public. Members of the task force shall serve for two-year terms. No member of the  
32 task force shall serve for more than three consecutive two-year terms.  
33 “(3) A member of the task force shall receive no compensation for services as a member. How-  
34 ever, subject to any applicable law regulating travel and other expenses of state officers and em-  
35 ployees, a member shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred

1 in the performance of official duties from such moneys as may be available therefor in the State  
2 Wildlife Fund.

3 “(4) The task force shall meet at such times and places as may be determined by the chair or  
4 by a majority of the members of the task force.

5 “(5) The duties of the task force are:

6 “(a) To advise the department in the development of a comprehensive cost-sharing program for  
7 the installation of fish screening or by-pass devices in water diversions.

8 “(b) To advise the department in establishing a stable and equitable funding system for the in-  
9 stallation and maintenance of fish screening and by-pass devices.

10 “(c) To advise the department in identifying sources and applying for grants from local, state  
11 and federal governmental agencies for funding the installation and maintenance of fish screening  
12 and by-pass devices.

13 “(d) To advise the department in monitoring fish screening programs.

14 “(e) To advise the department in a survey and study of fish screening technology to determine  
15 the most cost-effective alternatives for screening in the various situations that may be encountered  
16 in the implementation of fish screening in this state.

17 “(f) To advise the department in preparing a report on the capital costs and effectiveness of the  
18 program provided in ORS 498.306.

19 “(g) To advise the department on the creation of the priority criteria and the priority listing  
20 referred to in ORS 498.306 [(13)(a) or (d)] **(14)(a) or (d)**.”

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
