SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Extends statute of limitations from 10 years to 12 years for action for recovery of real property or for recovery of possession of real property.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to statute of limitations; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 12.050. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. ORS 12.050 is amended to read: 4

12.050. An action for the recovery of real property, or for the recovery of the possession thereof, 5

shall be commenced within [10] 12 years. [No] An action [shall] may not be maintained for such 7 recovery unless it [appear] appears that the plaintiff, an ancestor, a predecessor[,] or a grantor was

seized or possessed of the premises in question within [10] 12 years before the commencement of the 8

action. 9

10 SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 12.050 by section 1 of this 2007 Act apply to any action commenced as described in ORS 12.020 on or after the effective date of this 2007 Act. 11
