Expands crime of tampering with witness to include inducing or attempting to induce witness or potential witness to provide false statement or to request dismissal of criminal charges.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 162.285 is amended to read:
5	162.285. (1) A person commits the crime of tampering with a witness if[:]
6	[(a)] the person knowingly induces or attempts to induce a witness or a person the person be-
7	lieves may be called as a witness in any pending or potential official proceeding to:
8	(a) Offer false testimony or unlawfully withhold any testimony; $[or]$
9	[(b) The person knowingly induces or attempts to induce a witness to]
10	(b) Provide a false statement to a prosecutor or law enforcement official about the facts
11	related to the official proceeding;
12	(c) Request that a prosecutor or law enforcement official dismiss pending criminal
13	charges; or
14	(d) Be absent from any official proceeding to which the person has been legally summoned.
15	(2) Tampering with a witness is a Class C felony.
