SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Expands crime of giving false information to peace officer for citation or arrest warrant to include giving false information for purpose of arrest based upon probable cause.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to giving false information to peace officer; amending ORS 162.385.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 162.385 is amended to read:

5 162.385. (1) A person commits the crime of giving false information to a peace officer for issuance or service of a citation or **for** an arrest [*warrant*] if the person knowingly uses or gives a false or fictitious name, address or date of birth to any peace officer for the purpose of:

8 (a) The officer's issuing or serving the person a citation under authority of ORS 133.055 to 9 133.076 or ORS chapter 153; [*or for the purpose of*]

10 (b) The officer's arresting the person on an arrest warrant issued under authority of ORS 11 133.110 or 133.120; **or**

12 (c) **The officer's arresting the person on the basis of probable cause.**

13 (2) A person who violates this section commits a Class A misdemeanor.
