

House Bill 2420

Sponsored by Representative BUTLER (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires that Oregon State Lottery Commission conduct biennial survey to determine revenue generated by certain persons playing lottery games.

Requires commission to report results of each biennial survey to Legislative Assembly.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to Oregon State Lottery Commission; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 461.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon State Lottery Commission shall conduct a biennial survey**
6 **to determine the revenue generated from lottery games played by persons who are not:**

7 (a) Citizens of the United States; or

8 (b) Lawful resident aliens.

9 (2) The commission shall report the results of each biennial survey to the Legislative
10 Assembly on or before June 1 of every odd-numbered year.

11 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding section 2 of this 2007 Act, the Oregon State Lottery Com-**
12 **mission shall report the results of its first survey to the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly**
13 **within 30 days from the effective date of this 2007 Act.**

14 **SECTION 4. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
16 **on its passage.**
