House Bill 2435

Sponsored by Representative GARRARD; Representative SCHAUFLER (at the request of Auto Appraisers of Oregon)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Establishes four types of vehicle appraiser certificates.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to vehicle appraiser certificates; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 819.230 and 822.700. 3

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

SECTION 1. Sections 2 to 7 of this 2007 Act are added to and made a part of the Oregon 5 6 Vehicle Code.

7 SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Transportation shall issue a vehicle appraiser certificate to a person if the person: 8

(a) Certifies that the person has the experience required by section 5 of this 2007 Act; 9 and 10

(b) Pays the fee for issuance of a vehicle appraiser certificate under ORS 822.700. 11

12 (2) A vehicle appraiser certificate issued under this section is subject to the following:

13(a) A certificate shall expire two years from the date of issuance unless renewed according to rules adopted by the department. 14

(b) The department may not renew a certificate until the holder has paid the fee for re-15newal of the certificate under ORS 822.700. 16

(c) The department may not issue or renew a certificate if the department has reasonable 17 grounds to believe that the applicant has been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor involv-18 19 ing fraud, dishonesty or moral turpitude during the three years prior to the date of application for issuance or renewal. 20

21(3) The department shall adopt rules to provide for issuance and renewal of vehicle ap-22praiser certificates under this section.

SECTION 3. (1) The Department of Transportation shall issue a certified vehicle ap-23 24 praiser certificate to a person if the person:

(a) Certifies that the person has the experience required by section 5 of this 2007 Act;

(b) Certifies completion of the education requirements under section 6 of this 2007 Act; 26 27and

28 (c) Pays the fee for issuance of a certified vehicle appraiser certificate under ORS 822.700.

(2) A certified vehicle appraiser certificate issued under this section shall expire two 29years from the date of issuance unless renewed according to rules adopted by the depart-30 ment. The department may renew a certificate if the applicant: 31

1 approved education programs described in subsection (2) of this section prior to submitting

3 (b) An applicant for renewal of a certificate must have completed a minimum of two 4 hours per year during the previous certification period of approved education programs de-5 scribed in subsection (2) of this section prior to submitting an application for renewal of the 6 certificate.

7 (2) Education programs required under subsection (1) of this section may be developed 8 by a motor vehicle industry organization and shall be submitted to the advisory committee 9 established under ORS 802.370 for approval. The committee shall approve any program that 10 pertains to vehicle appraisal and includes instruction in state and federal law.

(3) Education programs approved as required under subsection (2) of this section may be
 provided by accredited educational institutions, private vocational schools, correspondence
 schools or trade associations.

<u>SECTION 7.</u> (1) The following education requirements apply to an applicant for a master
 certified vehicle appraiser certificate under section 4 of this 2007 Act:

(a) An applicant for issuance of a certificate must complete a minimum of eight hours
 of approved education programs described in subsection (2) of this section prior to submitting an application for issuance of the certificate; and

(b) An applicant for renewal of a certificate must have completed a minimum of two
 hours per year during the previous certification period of approved education programs de scribed in subsection (2) of this section prior to submitting an application for renewal of the
 certificate.

(2) Education programs required under subsection (1) of this section may be developed
 by a motor vehicle industry organization and shall be submitted to the advisory committee
 established under ORS 802.370 for approval. The committee shall approve any program that
 pertains to vehicle appraisal and includes instruction in state and federal law.

(3) Education programs approved as required under subsection (2) of this section may be
 provided by accredited educational institutions, private vocational schools, correspondence
 schools or trade associations.
