

# House Bill 2443

Sponsored by Representative LIM

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires that Oregon Liquor Control Commission prepare and make available small business impact statement before issuing new off-premises sales license for premises that are located within 500 feet of premises already licensed under off-premises sales license and operated by licensee with five or fewer employees.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to off-premises sales licenses.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 471.**

5 **SECTION 2. The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall prepare and make available a**  
6 **small business impact statement before issuing a new off-premises sales license for premises**  
7 **that are located within 500 feet of premises already licensed under an off-premises sales li-**  
8 **cence and operated by a licensee with five or fewer employees. The small business impact**  
9 **statement shall reflect the anticipated economic effect of the new licensed premises on the**  
10 **existing licensed premises, including loss of revenues from sales of alcoholic beverages and**  
11 **other merchandise sold at the existing licensed premises. The small business impact state-**  
12 **ment shall be made available on the website operated by the commission.**
