

House Bill 2446

Sponsored by Representative CAMERON (at the request of Steve Moore)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes placement of video lottery game terminals in establishments holding brewery-public house license issued by Oregon Liquor Control Commission.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to video lottery game terminals in establishments with brewery-public house licenses;
3 amending ORS 461.217.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 461.217 is amended to read:

6 461.217. (1) As used in this section, "video lottery game retailer" means a contractor under
7 contract with the Oregon State Lottery to place video lottery game terminals on premises author-
8 ized by the contract.

9 (2) A video lottery game terminal that offers a video lottery game authorized by the Director
10 of the Oregon State Lottery [*shall*] **may** be placed for operation only on the premises of an estab-
11 lishment that has a contract with the Oregon State Lottery as a video lottery game retailer. The
12 terminal must be within the control of an employee of the video lottery game retailer. [*It shall*] **A**
13 **terminal may** not be placed in any other business or location.

14 (3) A video lottery game terminal [*shall*] **may** be placed only on the premises of an establishment
15 licensed by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission with a full **on-premises sales license**, [*or*] **a**
16 limited on-premises sales license **or a brewery-public house license**. A video lottery game terminal
17 [*shall*] **may** be placed only in that part of the premises that is posted by the **Oregon Liquor Control**
18 Commission as being closed to minors. In addition to the requirements of this subsection, the di-
19 rector may by rule establish such other criteria and conditions as the director determines appro-
20 priate for the placement of video lottery game terminals in establishments.

21 (4) No more than six video lottery terminals [*shall*] **may** be placed in or on premises described
22 in subsection (3) of this section.

23 (5) No more than 10 video lottery game terminals may be placed on the premises of a race meet
24 licensee licensed under ORS 462.020 that qualifies as a video lottery game retailer.
