

# House Bill 2447

Sponsored by Representative LIM

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Declares January 13 of each year to be Korean American Day. Establishes Korean American Day Commission to promote, organize and coordinate Korean American Day celebrations.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to Korean American Day.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) January 13 of each year shall be known as Korean American Day. The**  
5 **Governor shall issue a proclamation each year calling upon the people of this state to cele-**  
6 **brate on January 13 the contributions to the state by Korean Americans in the arts, sci-**  
7 **ences, commerce and education.**

8 **(2) The Korean American Day Commission is established. The commission has seven**  
9 **members, appointed by the Governor.**

10 **(3) The term of office of each member of the Korean American Day Commission is four**  
11 **years, but a member serves at the pleasure of the Governor. Before the expiration of the**  
12 **term of a member, the Governor shall appoint a successor. A member is eligible for reap-**  
13 **pointment one time. If there is a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make an ap-**  
14 **pointment to become immediately effective for the unexpired term.**

15 **(4) Members of the Korean American Day Commission serve without compensation or**  
16 **payment of expenses.**

17 **(5) The Korean American Day Commission shall promote, organize and coordinate**  
18 **Korean American Day celebrations. The commission shall seek private and public involve-**  
19 **ment in the celebrations.**
