House Bill 2496

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Imposes fee for issuance of first Oregon certificate of title. Allocates moneys from fee among Department of Transportation, counties and cities.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to certificate of title fees; creating new provisions; amending ORS 366.739 and 803.090; and providing for revenue raising that requires approval by a three-fifths majority.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - **SECTION 1.** ORS 803.090 is amended to read:
- 6 803.090. The following fees are the fees for the transaction described:
 - (1) The transfer fee under ORS 803.092:
- 8 (a) For a salvage title, \$17.

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- 9 (b) For trailers eligible for permanent registration under ORS 803.415 (1) and motor vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating over 26,000 pounds, excluding motor homes, \$90.
 - (c) For vehicles other than vehicles for which the title fee is described in paragraph (b) of this subsection, \$55.
 - (2) The fee for issuance of a certificate of title under ORS 803.045:
 - (a) For trailers eligible for permanent registration under ORS 803.415 (1) and motor vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating over 26,000 pounds, excluding motor homes, \$90.
- 16 (b) For vehicles other than vehicles for which the title fee is described in paragraph (a) of this subsection, \$55.
 - (3) The fee for issuance of a salvage title certificate under ORS 803.140, \$17.
 - (4) The fee for issuance of a duplicate or replacement certificate of title under ORS 803.065:
- 20 (a) For a duplicate or replacement salvage title certificate, \$17.
 - (b) For trailers eligible for permanent registration under ORS 803.415 (1) and motor vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating over 26,000 pounds, excluding motor homes, \$90.
 - (c) For vehicles other than vehicles for which the title fee is described in paragraph (b) of this subsection, \$55.
 - (5) The fee under subsection (4) of this section must be paid at the same time as a transfer fee under this section if application is made at the same time as application for transfer.
 - (6) The fee for issuance of a new certificate of title under ORS 803.220 indicating a change of name or address:
 - (a) For a new salvage title certificate, \$17.
- 30 (b) For trailers eligible for permanent registration under ORS 803.415 (1) and motor vehicles 31 with a gross vehicle weight rating over 26,000 pounds, excluding motor homes, \$90.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

- (c) For vehicles other than vehicles for which the title fee is described in paragraph (b) of this subsection, \$55.
- (7) The fee for late presentation of certificate of title under ORS 803.105, \$25 from the 31st day after the transfer through the 60th day after the transfer and \$50 thereafter.
- (8) The fees for title transactions involving a form of title other than a certificate shall be the amounts established by the Department of Transportation by rule under ORS 803.012.
- (9) The fee for issuance of a first Oregon certificate of title for a vehicle for which registration fees are established under ORS 803.420, \$100, in addition to the fee required by subsection (2) of this section.
- <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 3 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle Code.
- <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding the provisions of ORS 802.100 and 802.110, moneys from the fee imposed under ORS 803.090 (9) shall be deposited in the State Highway Fund without deduction for administrative expenses of the Department of Transportation relating to the provision of driver and motor vehicle services.
 - SECTION 4. Section 5 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 366.
- SECTION 5. Moneys from the fee imposed by ORS 803.090 (9) shall be allocated as follows:
- (1) 50 percent to the Department of Transportation.
- (2) 30 percent to counties for distribution as provided in ORS 366.762.
 - (3) 20 percent to cities for distribution as provided in ORS 366.800.
 - **SECTION 6.** ORS 366.739 is amended to read:
 - 366.739. Except as otherwise provided in ORS 366.744 and section 5 of this 2007 Act, the taxes collected under ORS 319.020, 319.530, 803.090, 803.420, 818.225, 825.476 and 825.480, minus \$71.2 million per biennium, shall be allocated 24.38 percent to counties under ORS 366.762 and 15.57 percent to cities under ORS 366.800.
