

House Bill 2496

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Imposes fee for issuance of first Oregon certificate of title. Allocates moneys from fee among Department of Transportation, counties and cities.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to certificate of title fees; creating new provisions; amending ORS 366.739 and 803.090; and
3 providing for revenue raising that requires approval by a three-fifths majority.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 803.090 is amended to read:

6 803.090. The following fees are the fees for the transaction described:

7 (1) The transfer fee under ORS 803.092:

8 (a) For a salvage title, \$17.

9 (b) For trailers eligible for permanent registration under ORS 803.415 (1) and motor vehicles
10 with a gross vehicle weight rating over 26,000 pounds, excluding motor homes, \$90.

11 (c) For vehicles other than vehicles for which the title fee is described in paragraph (b) of this
12 subsection, \$55.

13 (2) The fee for issuance of a certificate of title under ORS 803.045:

14 (a) For trailers eligible for permanent registration under ORS 803.415 (1) and motor vehicles
15 with a gross vehicle weight rating over 26,000 pounds, excluding motor homes, \$90.

16 (b) For vehicles other than vehicles for which the title fee is described in paragraph (a) of this
17 subsection, \$55.

18 (3) The fee for issuance of a salvage title certificate under ORS 803.140, \$17.

19 (4) The fee for issuance of a duplicate or replacement certificate of title under ORS 803.065:

20 (a) For a duplicate or replacement salvage title certificate, \$17.

21 (b) For trailers eligible for permanent registration under ORS 803.415 (1) and motor vehicles
22 with a gross vehicle weight rating over 26,000 pounds, excluding motor homes, \$90.

23 (c) For vehicles other than vehicles for which the title fee is described in paragraph (b) of this
24 subsection, \$55.

25 (5) The fee under subsection (4) of this section must be paid at the same time as a transfer fee
26 under this section if application is made at the same time as application for transfer.

27 (6) The fee for issuance of a new certificate of title under ORS 803.220 indicating a change of
28 name or address:

29 (a) For a new salvage title certificate, \$17.

30 (b) For trailers eligible for permanent registration under ORS 803.415 (1) and motor vehicles
31 with a gross vehicle weight rating over 26,000 pounds, excluding motor homes, \$90.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1 (c) For vehicles other than vehicles for which the title fee is described in paragraph (b) of this
2 subsection, \$55.

3 (7) The fee for late presentation of certificate of title under ORS 803.105, \$25 from the 31st day
4 after the transfer through the 60th day after the transfer and \$50 thereafter.

5 (8) The fees for title transactions involving a form of title other than a certificate shall be the
6 amounts established by the Department of Transportation by rule under ORS 803.012.

7 **(9) The fee for issuance of a first Oregon certificate of title for a vehicle for which reg-**
8 **istration fees are established under ORS 803.420, \$100, in addition to the fee required by**
9 **subsection (2) of this section.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle**
11 **Code.**

12 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of ORS 802.100 and 802.110, moneys from the**
13 **fee imposed under ORS 803.090 (9) shall be deposited in the State Highway Fund without de-**
14 **duction for administrative expenses of the Department of Transportation relating to the**
15 **provision of driver and motor vehicle services.**

16 **SECTION 4. Section 5 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 366.**

17 **SECTION 5. Moneys from the fee imposed by ORS 803.090 (9) shall be allocated as follows:**

18 **(1) 50 percent to the Department of Transportation.**

19 **(2) 30 percent to counties for distribution as provided in ORS 366.762.**

20 **(3) 20 percent to cities for distribution as provided in ORS 366.800.**

21 **SECTION 6. ORS 366.739 is amended to read:**

22 366.739. Except as otherwise provided in ORS 366.744 **and section 5 of this 2007 Act**, the taxes
23 collected under ORS 319.020, 319.530, 803.090, 803.420, 818.225, 825.476 and 825.480, minus \$71.2
24 million per biennium, shall be allocated 24.38 percent to counties under ORS 366.762 and 15.57 per-
25 cent to cities under ORS 366.800.
