

# House Bill 2510

Sponsored by Representatives LIM, BUCKLEY; Representatives BERGER, BRUN, ESQUIVEL, FLORES, GILLIAM, GIROD, MINNIS, OLSON, RICHARDSON, RILEY, SCHAUFLE, WHISNANT, Senators METSGER, MONNES ANDERSON

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires student who receives diploma from school district to complete three years of science prior to high school graduation. Allows student who does not meet requirement to receive diploma if student has met or exceeded academic content standards for science or if student displays proficiency in science.

Applies new science requirement to students who receive high school diploma on or after July 1, 2010.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to high school graduation requirements; amending ORS 329.451 and section 3, chapter 827,  
3 Oregon Laws 2005.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 329.451 is amended to read:

6 329.451. (1) In order to receive a high school diploma from a school district, a student must meet  
7 the requirements established by the State Board of Education and, while in grades 9 through 12,  
8 must complete:

9 (a) At least 24 credit hours, as defined by rule of the board;

10 (b) Three years of mathematics; [*and*]

11 (c) Four years of English; **and**

12 **(d) Three years of science.**

13 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a school district may award a diploma to a  
14 student who does not meet the requirements of subsection (1)(b), [*or*] (c) **or (d)** of this section if the  
15 student:

16 (a) Has met or exceeded the academic content standards for mathematics, [*or*] English **or sci-**  
17 **ence** established by the board; or

18 (b) Displays proficiency in mathematics, [*or*] English **or science** at a level established by the  
19 board.

20 **SECTION 2.** Section 3, chapter 827, Oregon Laws 2005, is amended to read:

21 **Sec. 3. (1)** The requirements of [*section 1 of this 2005 Act*] **ORS 329.451 (1)(a) to (c)** apply to  
22 students who receive a high school diploma from a school district on or after July 1, 2009.

23 **(2) The requirements of ORS 329.451 (1)(d) apply to students who receive a high school**  
24 **diploma from a school district on or after July 1, 2010.**
