## House Bill 2511

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Expands crime of criminal mischief in second degree to include tampering or interfering with gates or signs that restrict closed roads.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to tampering with road signs; amending ORS 164.354.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> ORS 164.354 is amended to read:
5	164.354. (1) A person commits the crime of criminal mischief in the second degree if:
6	(a) The person violates ORS 164.345, and as a result thereof, damages property in an amount
7	exceeding \$100; or
8	(b) Having no right to do so nor reasonable ground to believe that the person has such right,
9	the person:
10	(A) Intentionally damages property of another[, or, the person];
11	(B) Recklessly damages property of another in an amount exceeding \$100[.]; or
12	(C) Intentionally tampers or interferes with a sign, gate or other device that is intended
13	to restrict public access to a road or mark it as currently closed to public use.
14	(2) Criminal mischief in the second degree is a Class A misdemeanor.

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [italic and bracketed] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
