

House Bill 2529

Sponsored by Representative THATCHER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits state agency from causing bill or other measure to be introduced before Legislative Assembly unless measure is sponsored by at least one member of Legislative Assembly.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to sponsorship of measures.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) A state agency may not cause a bill or other measure to be introduced**
5 **before the Legislative Assembly unless the measure is sponsored by at least one member of**
6 **the Legislative Assembly.**

7 **(2) For the purposes of this section, "state agency" means an officer, board, commission,**
8 **department or division in the executive department, as defined in ORS 174.112.**
