House Bill 2532

Sponsored by Representative SCOTT (at the request of Dylan and Shellie Digby)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires juvenile court that transfers jurisdiction to another court to send certified copies of court records pertaining to juvenile court proceeding to court in which proceeding is pending and to notify all parties of transfer.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to juvenile court jurisdiction.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> If a juvenile court transfers jurisdiction over a proceeding as provided in 5 ORS 419B.127, 419B.130 and 419B.132 or authorizes another court of competent jurisdiction 6 to enter a judgment of adoption of a child who is a party to the juvenile court proceeding, 7 the juvenile court shall:

8 (1) Prior to the transfer or authorization, notify all parties to the juvenile court pro-9 ceeding, including a court appointed special advocate under ORS 419A.170, if appointed, and 10 an intervenor granted intervention to the original proceeding under ORS 419B.116, of the 11 transfer of jurisdiction; and 12 (2) Send certified copies of the court records pertaining to the juvenile court proceeding

12 (2) Send certified copies of the court records pertaining to (13 to the court in which the proceeding is pending.

14 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 419B.
