

House Bill 2534

Sponsored by Representative BUTLER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows county community corrections agency to reject, based on offender's noncompliance or outstanding warrants, application for transfer of offender's supervision to county.

2 Relating to transfer of supervision of offenders between counties.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 423.500 to**
5 **423.560.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) A county community corrections agency may reject an application for**
7 **transfer of an offender's supervision to the county because the offender:**

8 (a) **Has failed to comply with conditions of release; or**

9 (b) **Is subject to an outstanding warrant.**

10 (2) **The Department of Corrections shall establish by rule guidelines for the transfer of**
11 **supervision of offenders from one county to another.**
