

# House Bill 2537

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND LABOR

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits employees of mass transit districts, transportation districts and municipal bus systems from striking or recognizing picket line of labor organization while performing official duties.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to public transportation employees; amending ORS 243.736.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 243.736 is amended to read:

5 243.736. (1) It [*shall be*] **is** unlawful for any emergency telephone worker, parole and probation  
6 officer who supervises adult offenders, police officer, firefighter, [*or*] guard at a correctional insti-  
7 tution or mental hospital **or employee of a mass transit district, transportation district or**  
8 **municipal bus system** to strike or recognize a picket line of a labor organization while in the  
9 performance of official duties.

10 (2) As used in this section[,]:

11 (a) "Emergency telephone worker" means a person whose official focal duties are receiving in-  
12 formation through a 9-1-1 emergency reporting system under ORS 401.710 to 401.816, relaying  
13 [*such*] **the** information to public or private safety agencies or dispatching emergency equipment or  
14 personnel in response to [*such*] **the** information.

15 (b) "**Mass transit district**" means a mass transit district established under ORS 267.010  
16 to 267.390.

17 (c) "**Transportation district**" means a transportation district established under ORS  
18 267.510 to 267.650.
