## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS TO HOUSE BILL 2538

On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, after the semicolon insert "repealing section 34, chapter 1  $\mathbf{2}$ \_, Oregon Laws 2007 (Enrolled House Bill 2117);". 3 On page 2, after line 20, insert: "SECTION 5. If House Bill 2117 becomes law, section 2 of this 2007 Act is amended to read: 4  $\mathbf{5}$ "Sec. 2. (1) The State Landscape Contractors Board shall adopt rules establishing continuing education requirements for landscape [contractors] construction professionals. The board may not 6 7 require landscape [contractors] construction professionals to take more than 10 hours of continu-8 ing education every year. 9 "(2) The board may approve programs for purposes of [landscape contractor] continuing educa-10 tion for landscape construction professionals and determine the number of hours to be credited 11 to the programs. The board shall ensure that continuing education opportunities for landscape 12 [contractors] construction professionals are readily available. 13 "(3) Programs approved by the board for continuing education purposes must be designed to di-14 rectly contribute to [landscape contractor] the professional competency of landscape construction 15professionals. Approved programs may include, but need not be limited to: 16 "(a) Professional development programs and technical meetings of professional associations for 17 [landscaping] landscape contracting businesses or for related industries such as pesticide applica-18 tion or irrigation auditing; 19 "(b) University or college courses related to [landscape contracting] landscaping or horticulture; 20 "(c) Professional staff training programs by [landscape contractor] associations of landscape 21construction professionals; and 22"(d) Online or other forms of educational programs. 23 "(4) The board may adopt rules establishing grounds for obtaining a waiver of [landscape con-24 tractor] the continuing education requirements for landscape construction professionals. The 25board may not allow a waiver for more than two consecutive years except for a waiver due to mil-26 itary service, retirement, disability, absence from the state, inactive status or extreme hardship. 27"SECTION 6. If House Bill 2117 becomes law, section 34, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 282007 (amending ORS 671.660) is repealed and ORS 671.660, as amended by section 3 of this 2007 29 Act, is amended to read: "671.660. (1) The fee for renewal of a license issued under ORS 671.510 to 671.710 shall be paid 30 31 annually on or before the last day of the month of the anniversary of issuance. 32"(2) The State Landscape Contractors Board may not issue a new license to a person who has been previously licensed under ORS 671.510 to 671.710 and whose license has expired, unless the 33 34 person makes written application on a form approved by the board and pays the required annual fee. 35The board may require the person to also pay a penalty fee.

1 "(3) If a license lapses for two years or more, the [*individual or business*] **person** must reapply 2 as for initial issuance of the license.

3 "(4) When a landscape contracting business renews its license, the business must submit the 4 names of all employees who are licensed landscape [contractors] construction professionals.

5 "(5) When a person renews a landscape [contractor] construction professional license, the 6 person must:

"(a) Submit the name of the employer if the person is currently performing landscaping work;
and

9 "(b) Demonstrate that the person has complied with the continuing education requirement 10 adopted by the board.

11 "SECTION 7. If House Bill 2117 becomes law, section 4 of this 2007 Act is amended to read:

"Sec. 4. (1) The State Landscape Contractors Board shall establish an initial continuing education requirement and a continuing education program approval process no later than March 1, 2008.
"(2) The amendments to ORS 671.660 by [section 3] sections 3 and 6 of this 2007 Act apply to the renewal of landscape [contractor] construction professional licenses that expire on or after January 1, 2009.
