

House Bill 2582

Sponsored by Representative GIROD; Representatives BERGER, THATCHER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires executive director of Oregon Government Standards and Practices Commission to be appointed by Governor and confirmed by Senate. Specifies that director serves at pleasure of commission.

2 Relating to executive director of Oregon Government Standards and Practices Commission; creating
3 new provisions; and amending ORS 244.310.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 244.310 is amended to read:

6 244.310. (1) **The Governor shall appoint an executive director** for the Oregon Government
7 Standards and Practices Commission. **The** [*shall appoint an*] executive director [*to*] **shall** serve at
8 the pleasure of the commission. **The appointment of the executive director is subject to con-**
9 **firmation by the Senate in the manner prescribed in ORS 171.562 and 171.565.**

10 (2) The executive director [*shall be*] **is** responsible for the administrative operations of the
11 commission and shall perform such other duties as may be designated or assigned to the executive
12 director from time to time by the commission. [*However,*]

13 (3) The commission [*shall*] **may** not delegate the power to [*make regulations*] **adopt rules** or
14 issue advisory opinions to the executive director.

15 **SECTION 2.** (1) **The Governor shall appoint an executive director under ORS 244.310, as**
16 **amended by section 1 of this 2007 Act, not later than March 1, 2008.**

17 (2) **The person serving as executive director on the effective date of this 2007 Act may**
18 **serve until an executive director is appointed and confirmed as provided in ORS 244.310, as**
19 **amended by section 1 of this 2007 Act.**
