1	On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 22 and insert:
2	"SECTION 1. ORS 329.451 is amended to read:
3	"329.451. (1) In order to receive a high school diploma from a school district, a student must
4	meet the requirements established by the State Board of Education and the school district and
5	while in grades 9 through 12, must complete:
6	"(a) At least 24 [credit hours] credits, as defined by rule of the board;
7	"(b) Three [years] credits of mathematics; and
8	"(c) Four [years] credits of English.
9	"(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a school district may award a diploma to a
10	student who does not [meet] satisfy the requirements of subsection (1)(b) or (c) of this section if the
11	student:
12	"(a) Has met or exceeded the academic content standards for mathematics or English established
13	by the board; or
14	"(b) Displays proficiency in mathematics or English at a level established by the board.
15	"(3) A student may satisfy the requirements of subsection (1) of this section in less than
16	four years. If a student satisfies the requirements of subsection (1) of this section and a
17	school district has the consent of the student's parent or guardian, the school district shall
18	award a diploma to the student upon request from the student.
19	"(4) If a school district has the consent of a student's parent or guardian, the school
20	district may advance the student to the next grade level if the student has satisfied the re-
21	quirements for the student's current grade level.
22	"(5) The requirement for obtaining the consent of a student's parent or guardian under
23	subsections (3) and (4) of this section does not apply to a student who is:
24	"(a) Emancipated pursuant to ORS 419B.550 to 419B.558; or
25	"(b) 18 years of age or older.".
