

House Bill 2611

Sponsored by Representative BUTLER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Permits owner of any qualified residential property to apply for second 15-year term of historic property special assessment.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to qualification for second term of historic property special assessment for residential
3 property; amending ORS 358.541.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 358.541 is amended to read:

6 358.541. *[(1)]* Residential property may *[not]* qualify for a second term of classification and spe-
7 cial assessment as historic property under this section unless $[:]$ **the historic property is disquali-**
8 **fied under ORS 358.515.**

9 *[(a) If the property is located within a city, the governing body of the city has adopted a resolution*
10 *or ordinance authorizing a second term of historic property classification and special assessment for*
11 *residential property; or]*

12 *[(b) If the property is located within unincorporated territory of a county, the governing body of the*
13 *county has adopted a resolution or ordinance authorizing a second term of historic property classi-*
14 *fication and special assessment for residential property.]*

15 *[(2) The city or county authorizing a second term of historic property classification and special*
16 *assessment for residential property shall send a copy of the authorizing resolution or ordinance to the*
17 *State Historic Preservation Officer.]*

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NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
