8	(1) A school that has accreditation recognized by the United States Department of Edu
9	cation.
10	(2) A school that has been approved by the Oregon Student Assistance Commission
11	through the Office of Degree Authorization to offer and confer degrees in Oregon.
12	(3) A community college.
13	(4) A state institution of higher education within the Oregon University System.
14	(5) The Oregon Health and Science University.
15	(6) A career school licensed under ORS 345.010 to 345.450.
