

# House Bill 2633

Sponsored by Representative HUNT; Representatives BUCKLEY, CLEM, KOMP

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Specifies types of schools at which Department of Human Services may provide vocational rehabilitation training.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to vocational rehabilitation services.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 344.511 to**  
5 **344.690.**

6 **SECTION 2. The Department of Human Services may provide vocational rehabilitation**  
7 **training only at the following schools:**

8 (1) **A school that has accreditation recognized by the United States Department of Edu-**  
9 **cation.**

10 (2) **A school that has been approved by the Oregon Student Assistance Commission**  
11 **through the Office of Degree Authorization to offer and confer degrees in Oregon.**

12 (3) **A community college.**

13 (4) **A state institution of higher education within the Oregon University System.**

14 (5) **The Oregon Health and Science University.**

15 (6) **A career school licensed under ORS 345.010 to 345.450.**
