## House Bill 2637

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires school districts to adopt policy prohibiting cyberbullying. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

| 10 | (2) "Harassment, intimidation or bullying" means:   |
| 11 | (a) Any act that substantially interferes with a student's educational benefits, opportunities or       |
| 12 | performance, that takes place on or immediately adjacent to school grounds, at any school-sponsored     |
| 13 | activity, on school-provided transportation or at any official school bus stop, and that has the effect |

| 15 | [(1)] (A) Physically harming a student or damaging a student's property;                                |
| 16 | [(2)] (B) Knowingly placing a student in reasonable fear of physical harm to the student of             |

| 20 | SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 339.351 by section 1 of this 2007 Act first apply to                   |

| 22 | SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public                   |
| 23 | peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect             |

July 1, 2007.
