## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies requirements and procedure for city to annex territory surrounded by city. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to annexation; creating new provisions; amending ORS 222.750; and declaring an emer-3 gency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 222.750 is amended to read:

6 222.750. (1) When territory not within a city is surrounded by the corporate boundaries of the

7 city, or by the corporate boundaries of the city and the ocean shore [or a stream, bay, lake or other

8 body of water, it is within the power and authority of that city to annex such territory. However], the

9 city may annex the territory pursuant to this section after holding at least one public hear-

10 ing on the subject for which notice has been mailed to each record owner of real property

11 in the territory proposed to be annexed.

12 (2) This section does not apply when the territory not within a city:

13 (a) Is surrounded entirely by water; or

(b) Is surrounded in part by a portion of the city that consists only of a public right of
way.

(3) Unless otherwise required by its charter, [annexation by] a city may annex territory under
this section [shall be] by ordinance or resolution subject to referendum, with or without the consent
of any owner of property within the territory or resident in the territory.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 222.750 by section 1 of this 2007 Act apply to
annexation ordinances and resolutions adopted on or after the effective date of this 2007 Act.
<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect
