SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Repeals provisions requiring Department of Human Services to eliminate or limit Oregon Health Plan coverage of dental, vision, hospital and drug services for 2005-2007 biennium. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to health services; repealing section 9, chapter 806, Oregon Laws 2005; and declaring an emergency. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. Section 9, chapter 806, Oregon Laws 2005, is repealed. SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect on its passage.
