House Bill 2724

Sponsored by Representative ROSENBAUM; Representatives BARKER, BUCKLEY, CANNON, CLEM, DINGFELDER, GALIZIO, JENSON, KOMP, ROBLAN, TOMEI, Senator AVAKIAN (at the request of Oregon School Employees Association)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Removes limit on number of hours retired member may work and still qualify for retirement under Public Employees Retirement System if retired member is employed by school district or education service district as other than teacher or management employee, or by community college as other than faculty member or management employee. Applies to Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to public employee retirement; amending ORS 238.082 and 238A.245.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 238.082 is amended to read: 4

238.082. (1) Subject to the limitations in subsection (2) of this section, any public employer may 5 employ any person receiving a service retirement allowance if the administrative head of [such] the 6 employer is satisfied that [such] **the** employment is in the public interest. 7

(2) The period or periods of employment by one or more public employers of any person receiv-8 ing a service retirement allowance may not total 1,040 hours or more in any calendar year; but if 9 10 the person is receiving old-age, survivors or disability insurance benefits under the federal Social 11 Security Act, the person may be employed for the number of hours for which the salary equals the maximum allowed for receipt of the full amount of those benefits to which the person is entitled. 12

13(3) The limitations on employment imposed by subsection (2) of this section do not apply to a retired member who is employed as a teacher or as an administrator, as those terms are defined in 14 ORS 342.120, if the retired member is employed by a school district or education service district that 1516 has its administrative office located within a county with a population of not more than 35,000 inhabitants according to the latest federal decennial census. A retired member who is employed as a 17 18 teacher, as defined in ORS 342.120, by the same public employer that employed the member at the 19 time of retirement remains in the same collective bargaining unit that included the member before 20 retirement.

(4) The limitations on employment imposed by subsection (2) of this section do not apply to a 22retired member who is employed:

(a) By the sheriff of a county with a population of fewer than 75,000 inhabitants, according to 23the latest federal decennial census; 24

25(b) By the municipal police department of a city with a population of fewer than 15,000 inhab-26 itants, according to the latest federal decennial census;

27(c) By the state or a county for work in a correctional institution located in a county with a 28 population of fewer than 75,000 inhabitants, according to the latest federal decennial census;

1 (d) By the Black Butte Ranch Rural Fire Protection District, the Black Butte Ranch Service 2 District or the Sunriver Service District; or

3 (e) By the Oregon State Police for work in a county with a population of fewer than 75,000 in4 habitants, according to the latest federal decennial census.

5 (5) The limitations on employment imposed by subsection (2) of this section do not apply to a 6 retired member who is employed to temporarily replace an employee who serves in the National 7 Guard or in a reserve component of the Armed Forces of the United States and who is called to 8 federal active duty.

9 (6) The limitations on employment imposed by subsection (2) of this section do not apply to a 10 retired member who is employed by a road assessment district organized under ORS 371.405 to 11 371.535.

12 (7) The limitations on employment imposed by subsection (2) of this section do not apply 13 to a retired member who is employed by a school district or an education service district as 14 other than a teacher or management employee, or by a community college as other than a 15 faculty member or management employee. A retired member who is employed under this 16 subsection by the same public employer that employed the member at the time of retirement 17 remains in the same collective bargaining unit that included the member before retirement. 18 [(7)] (8) Subsections (3) to [(6)] (7) of this section do not apply to any member who retires under

19 the provisions of ORS 238.280 (1) or (2).

20 [(8)] (9) Employment under this section does not affect the status of a person as a retired 21 member of the system and a recipient of retirement benefits under this chapter.

22 SECTION 2. ORS 238A.245 is amended to read:

23 238A.245. (1) Except as provided in [*subsection (3) of*] this section, the Public Employees Retire-24 ment Board shall cease making pension payments to a retired member of the pension program who 25 is reemployed by a participating public employer in a qualifying position. A retired member of the 26 pension program who is employed in a qualifying position becomes an active member of the pension 27 program without serving the probationary period provided for in ORS 238A.100.

(2) If a retired member of the pension program is reemployed under the provisions of this section, any option chosen by the member under ORS 238A.190 is canceled, and upon retiring thereafter
the member may elect any option provided for in ORS 238A.180 and 238A.190. The board shall recalculate the pension of the member upon subsequent retirement.

(3) A retired member of the pension program who becomes a member of the Legislative Assembly shall continue to receive the pension elected by the member. A retired member of the pension
program who becomes a member of the Legislative Assembly may not elect under ORS 237.650 to
become an active member of the Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan or a legislator member of
the state deferred compensation plan.

(4) A retired member may be employed in a qualifying position by a school district or an education service district as other than a teacher or management employee, or by a community college as other than a faculty member or management employee, without loss of pension or limitation on the number of hours employed. A retired member who is employed under this subsection by the same participating public employer that employed the member at the time of retirement remains in the same collective bargaining unit that included the member before retirement.

44 (5) Subsection (4) of this section does not apply to any member who retires under the
 45 provisions of ORS 238A.185.
