SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Establishes state policy relating to state-funded research that benefits private enterprise. Requires certain state agencies that make research grants to ensure that one purpose of research is to keep or create jobs in Oregon.]

Establishes state policy that state-funded research benefiting private enterprise must encourage economic development and job creation in Oregon.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state-funded research that benefits private enterprise.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. It is the policy of this state that state-funded research that benefits private enterprise must encourage economic development and job creation in Oregon.
