## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2733

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon insert "creating new provisions; and"
2	and after "ORS" insert "442.445,".
3	On page 2, line 31, after "entity's" insert "record-keeping".
4	In line 33, after "systems" insert "or controls".
5	On page 3, after line 21, insert:
6	"SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 441.
7	"SECTION 4. (1) A health care facility shall file with the Administrator of the Office for
8	Oregon Health Policy and Research a protection of health information report no later than
9	120 days following the close of the fiscal year. The report shall be on a form prescribed by
10	the administrator, shall be signed by the chief executive officer of the facility and must:
11	"(a) State the responsibility of the health care facility's management for establishing and
12	maintaining adequate safeguards and procedures for protecting the confidentiality of indi-
13	vidually identifiable health information that the facility retains in electronic and hard copy
14	form;
15	"(b) Contain assurances that the signing officer has disclosed to the board of directors
16	of the facility:
17	"(A) All significant deficiencies in the design or operation of record-keeping systems or
18	controls that could adversely affect the facility's ability to protect the confidentiality of in-
19	dividually identifiable health information;
20	"(B) Any breaches of the security of individually identifiable health information, whether
21	material or not, that involve management, staff or employees of the facility who have a sig-
22	nificant role in the facility's record-keeping systems or controls; and
23	"(C) All necessary steps that have been taken to address deficiencies in the design or
24	operation of record-keeping systems or controls and to resolve any material weaknesses
25	identified by the facility; and
26	"(c) Contain assurances that the signing officer has identified for the board any material
27	weaknesses in the record-keeping systems or controls.
28	"(2) The administrator may adopt all rules necessary to carry out the provisions of this
29	section.
30	"(3) As used in this section, 'individually identifiable health information' has the meaning
31	given that term in ORS 192.519.
32	"SECTION 5. ORS 442.445 is amended to read:
33	"442.445. (1) Any health care facility that fails to perform as required in ORS 442.400 to 442.463
34	and section 4 of this 2007 Act and rules of the Office for Oregon Health Policy and Research may
35	be subject to a civil penalty.

- "(2) The Administrator of the Office for Oregon Health Policy and Research shall adopt a schedule of penalties not to exceed \$500 per day of violation, determined by the severity of the violation.
  - "(3) Civil penalties under this section shall be imposed as provided in ORS 183.745.
- "(4) Civil penalties imposed under this section may be remitted or mitigated upon such terms and conditions as the administrator considers proper and consistent with the public health and safety.
  - "(5) Civil penalties incurred under any law of this state are not allowable as costs for the purpose of rate determination or for reimbursement by a third-party payer.".
