## House Bill 2744

Sponsored by Representative FLORES (at the request of Susan and Jim McLaren)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows patrons of winery licensee to make wine if winemaking is conducted under direct supervision of licensee or employees of licensee.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to alcoholic beverages; amending ORS 471.403.

## **3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** ORS 471.403 is amended to read:

5 471.403. (1) No person shall brew, ferment, distill, blend or rectify any alcoholic liquor unless 6 licensed so to do by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission. However, the Liquor Control Act does 7 not apply to the making or keeping of naturally fermented wines and fruit juices or beer in the 8 home, for home consumption and not for sale.

9 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the holder of a brewery-public house license 10 or a brewery license may allow patrons to brew malt beverages not to exceed 14 percent alcoholic 11 content by volume if the brewing is conducted under the direct supervision of the licensee or em-12 ployees of the licensee. Malt beverages produced under this subsection may not be sold by the pa-13 tron or consumed on the licensed premises.

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the holder of a winery license may allow patrons to make wine if the winemaking is conducted under the direct supervision of the licensee or employees of the licensee. Wine produced under this subsection may not be sold
