

House Bill 2749

Sponsored by Representatives GARRARD, SCHAUFLEER; Representatives BARKER, JENSON, ROSENBAUM, P SMITH

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires school districts to provide instruction in financial education in secondary schools. Directs Department of Education to prepare financial education program.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to financial education; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) All school districts shall provide courses of instruction in financial edu-**
5 **cation in the secondary schools of each district.**

6 **(2) The Department of Education shall prepare and make available to school districts a**
7 **comprehensive financial education program.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2007 Act first applies to the 2007-2008 academic year.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
11 **July 1, 2007.**
