SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Specifies that qualified person who resides in shelter, park, motor home, marina or other identifiable location may register to vote. Provides that person may use office of county clerk as mailing address for purposes of registration.

4	SECTION 1. ORS 247.038 is amended to read:
5	247.038. (1) A qualified person who is homeless [shall] or resides in a shelter, park, motor
6	home, marina or other identifiable location may not be denied the opportunity to register to
7	vote.
8	(2) For purposes of this chapter:
9	(a) The residence address of a [homeless] person [shall] who is homeless or resides in a shell
10	ter, park, motor home, marina or other identifiable location may be any place within the
11	county describing the physical location of the person; and
12	(b) The mailing address of a [homeless] person who is homeless or resides in a shelter, park
13	motor home, marina or other identifiable location may be the office of the county clerk.
