

# House Bill 2764

Sponsored by Representative SHIELDS (at the request of Federation of Oregon Parole and Probation Officers)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Limits number of medium and high risk offenders that may be supervised by parole and probation officers who engage in case supervision.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to parole and probation officers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "parole and probation officer" has the meaning**  
5 **given that term in ORS 181.610.**

6 **(2) A parole and probation officer who is engaged in case supervision may not supervise**  
7 **more than 60 medium and high risk adults on parole, probation or post-prison supervision**  
8 **per month, averaged over a 12-month period.**
