## House Bill 2764

Sponsored by Representative SHIELDS (at the request of Federation of Oregon Parole and Probation Officers)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Limits number of medium and high risk offenders that may be supervised by parole and probation officers who engage in case supervision.

2	Relating to parole and probation officers.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "parole and probation officer" has the meaning
5	given that term in ORS 181.610.
6	(2) A parole and probation officer who is engaged in case supervision may not supervise
7	more than 60 medium and high risk adults on parole, probation or post-prison supervision
8	per month, averaged over a 12-month period.
